COLLEGE LEADERS AT THE UN: KOREA 2022 OUTCOME DOCUMENT SUMMARY

31 JANUARY - 04 FEBRUARY 2022

1 INTRODUCTION

We, the ninth College Representatives of Korea, have convened virtually (online via Zoom) at the United Nations program conducted by the World Federation of United Nations Associations to assimilate the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and address international society referring to Goals 11, 13, and 16.

2 A CALL TO ACTION FOR GLOBAL AND KOREAN CIVIL SOCIETY

GOAL 11 (SUSTAINABLE CITIES AND COMMUNITIES)

First, we urge the United Nations to support developing countries facing fundamental and urgent pollution problems to apply innovative new technologies to solve problems partially, not by limiting citizens' activities increasing their burden.

Second, we recommend the World Bank or KOICA with the Indian government to apply the photocatalyst produced from wastewater sludge to transport-related facilities such as roads, traffic signs, and sidewalk blocks after the pilot project in Delhi city.

Third, we request UNEP, TERI, and KICT to make a cooperation center as the stakeholders. The institution-focused approach must tackle a sustainable "system" rather than person-focused capacity building.

Fourth, we urge Hanoi city municipal to launch a shared e-scooter service that can be used as intermodal transportation to enhance public transportation accessibility, having a publicly owned and privately operated system as a basis.

Fifth, we call on UN HABITAT to help the Vietnam government establish a long-term transport plan that integrates various transportation modes, including micro-mobility and enacting laws regarding legal status and safety regulations of 2 or 3 wheelers.

Sixth, we suggest UNEP, ASEAN Catalytic Green Finance Facility, Vietnam State Bank to partake in and gather stakeholders for ESG that aims to raise sustainable funds for shared e scooter service operations.

GOAL 13 (CLIMATE ACTION)

First, we call on to control the economic activities exacerbating the salinity levels and adopting soil salinization management systems.

Second, we ask for financial help from the national governments of developing countries to resolve the lack of education for environmental migrants.

Third, we request sustainable employment, proposing the government help connect the relocated to get a job in the ecotourism industry.

Fourth, we urge the United Nations Environmental Programme to initiate the installation of smart bins and incorporate the ActNow campaign to provide educational materials through a QR code on smart bins that can raise awareness among tourists in the Caribbean SIDS.

Fifth, we recommend the UNEP establish (recycling) waste export partnership between the Caribbean SIDS to overcome waste disposal problems.

Sixth, we recommend UNEP implement a green rating system on booking platforms to encourage hotels to commit green action through social pressure and raise consumers' awareness.

GOAL 16 (PEACE, JUSTICE, AND STRONG INSTITUTIONS)

First, we urge all international communities to continuously pay attention to child soldiers' issues and create a systemic program of social reintegration for children who have experienced violence, which is the most vulnerable group.

Second, we recommend IOM establish gender-sensitive shelters providing humanitarian aid regardless of the region and UNICEF to implement a monitoring system that can result in true reconciliation among the local community and child soldiers.

Third, we recommend the policy's beneficiaries, local community members, target government, organizations, support from appropriate funds, and donor nations to 'BE ONE' and cooperate to fully and successfully implement the proposed policies.

Fourth, we call on the world to provide equal STEM educational opportunities to every gender and support their dreams to keep going in the future.

Fifth, we request all nations to harness technology and science for a good purpose that would unite people together toward sustainable development for future generations.

3 CONCLUSION

"Leave no one behind", under the central promise of the 2030 Agenda for SDGs, we, the ninth college leaders at the UN, acknowledge the significance of keeping the unequivocal commitment on the global scale for sustainable development. To tackle all forms of discrimination and create a universally inclusive environment, we are continuously aware of the need for a systematic approach to accomplish sustainable cities and communities, climate action and peace and justice.
